COURSE DETAILS

The Head and Neck Course 2018 is a two-day course for clinicians and nurses who are interested in Head and Neck Surgery, and in particular the management of recurrent head and neck tumours. The emphasis of the course is to promote exchange of knowledge on patient care on a multidisciplinary level.

Recurrent head and neck tumours are always challenging to manage. The disease is usually loco-regionally advanced at the time of diagnosis. Sequels from previous surgery or radiotherapy increase the post-operative risk of complications, some of which are potentially serious and life-threatening. Reconstruction is always more difficult because of the limited choice of flaps and vessels in the neck. Further adjuvant treatment may not be feasible, and as a result, the oncological outcome of salvage surgery may be compromised.

Day 1 of the Course consists of lectures that cover the essential concepts in the management of recurrent head and neck cancer. Live surgery demonstration will be performed on Day 2 of the Course. The entire procedure will be demonstrated through direct video transmission from the operating theatre to the lecture hall.
